

What is a Sneak-a-Peak?

"Sneak-a-Peak" is a unique visit by Santa on Christmas Eve after the children have gone to bed and are dreaming of the morning to come! Parents put presents from Santa on the counter or table and Santa arrives at the agreed time and places the gifts in his sack. Cookies and milk are in place and any reindeer food for the beloved flying crew. When all is set, parents wake up the children to tell them that "Santa is here! Wake up and see!" Together, all quietly they "sneak-a-peak" as the jolly old fellow does his work placing presents, filling stockings, and eating cookies and drinking milk. Santa then departs as the children look with awe! Will they go back to sleep after that? Who knows! But they will never forget what they just saw! This whole process takes about 5 to 10 minutes and is done between 8pm and 10:30pm. To make this unique visit special, it requires advanced planning and communication. A phone interview with Santa (when the children are not around) to go over the details is required. Some of the information needed would be...

- 1) Where does Santa come in at? Make sure the presents are at this location.
- 2) Are there any pets (cats, dogs) that will not be barking or in the way?
- 3) Where is the Christmas tree location?
- 4) Is there anything you request out of Santa to do or say?
- 5) What are the names of the children, and will the packages be marked with their names?

How this typically will go down, is Santa will park down the street. When he arrives, he will text a contact person who will be meeting him at a decided entrance to which Santa will put any presents into his bag and he will quietly enter the residence. At this point the parents/guardians will get the child(ern) and they will be instructed that they think Santa is in the house and lets not make a sound and lets "sneak-a-peak." Santa will proceed to perform and place the presents under the tree. Additional performance may be requested. Then Santa will relax and start to eat the cookies and drink the milk. This is when it is time for the child(ren) to go back to bed. Not sure if they will sleep at this point though. From that moment in time Santa enters and leaves this will all take place in a matter of 5 to 10 minutes, but I guarantee this will be a memory the child(ren) will NEVER forget.
